Preparing for Federal Cannabis Regulation & Compliance:

Every current congressional proposal to end federal cannabis prohibition grants regulatory authority to the U.S Department of Treasury, and its agency the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB). It's clear that legislators want TTB to regulate cannabis, as they already do for other adult use consumables, alcohol, and tobacco. Relying on decades of knowledge and experience gained while working at TTB, its predecessor, the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco, and Firearms (ATF), and in the alcoholic beverage industry, Jim and Harry will discuss pending legislation, and the most likely cannabis reform outcomes.
